As article is a word that comes before a noun to show whether it's specific organization 'a', 'an' and 'the' are called articles.

'a is used before nouns that start with a consonant sound.

an is used before nouns that start with a vowel sound.

the is used for a specific noun.

a ball, a chair, a train, a boy

an ostrich, an egg, an igloo

the Himalayas, the Ganga river, the bag with red dots

Examples: That is a stall. There is an umbrella on the stall.






