

Class 10 – Integrated Project – Term 2

Theme: Tea: An Incredible Beverage

Nature of the project: Group Project

Instruction:

- Research and find information about tea, its history related to Indian and how it became one of the most popular beverages in India.
 - How as tea discovered?
 - How did British Government (ruling India before 1947) bring tea to India?
 - What different strategies did British Government use to make tea popular in India?
 - How did the states in the North East part of India become the tea producing states?
 - Why is tea so popular in India?
- Collect information about the rise or fall in the sales of tea in India for last 3 decades.
 - Find information of the sales of tea in India of last 10 years
 - Find information of the tea consumption countries
 - Find information related to maximum tea producing countries

Present this information in the form of bar diagram or pie chart.

- Research and find information about the process of tea production, the condition required for tea farming, the soil type and the climatic conditions.
 - What kind of climate is required for tea farming?
 - What kind of soil is required for tea farming?
 - What different care is to be taken for tea farming?
- Find an old newspaper advertisement for a tea product. Understand what different aspects are studied to create an effective newspaper advertisement for tea.
- Create a newspaper advertisement for an imaginary tea product.

How your project should look like:

- Cover Page:
 - It should be colourful and decorative. Draw picture and stick pictures and images on the front page.
 - It should have the title of the project.
 - It should have the names of the group members.



- Mention that the project is for Term 2
- Mention the name of the school as well.

Front Page:

- This page should not have any image, any colour, any picture.
- It should just have name of the project and the names of the group members.

Acknowledgement:

Write a thank you paragraph mentioning names of those who helped you and inspired you to complete this project.

■ Index:

Make an index where you will write the names of your content and the page numbers. Keep it simple. You may design a border for it.

■ Introduction:

In the form of a narrative paragraph, write how tea has become an incredible part of India lives. Mention the tea drinking habits of people you know. Also write how often they prefer to drink tea over any other beverages. Conclude this introduction with a remark of knowing more about tea. (150 to 200 words) (Include relevant images)

The Journey of Tea:

In this chapter, you have share information about how tea was discovered and how it was spread across the world. Also mention about how British Government in Pre-independent India promoted tea. Share the information about how tea became so popular in India. (200 to 250 words) (Include relevant images)

■ Tea in Numbers:

In this chapter you are going to include the data related to country-wise tea production, tea consumption and tea sale of the last 10 years. After presenting the data in the graphical format, give a conclusion to your findings. (Graph and conclusion of 80-100 words)

■ Tea Production in India:

In this chapter, you must give the details of the states where tea is harvested. Share the details related to the type of soil needed for tea production, type of climate required and how only few states in India qualify for tea production.

How tea has been sold in India:

Write a small paragraph of about 70-80 words mentioning what different strategies were used in order to increase the sale of tea for years. Select an old or a new newspaper cut out of tea product advertisement and paste it on the page.

Also, make you own tea product's advertisement and design it accordingly.



■ Tea in Mainstream Media:

In the form of a conclusion write how tea has been presented as a stress reliever, relationship enhancer, mood enhancer in the mainstream media like TV commercials, web series, TV shows and movies. (80-100 words)

Reflection:

Use the same questions for reflection that you have used in the integrated project of Term 1.

PowerPoint Presentation:

As a group, you have to present the project in the form of a PowerPoint as well. Each group member will be assessed on the basis of their knowledge and efforts taken to make this project.
