### **Pronouns**

**Definition:** A <u>pronoun</u> is a word that can replace a noun in a sentence. A **pronoun** is used in place of a noun to avoid repetition.

Pronouns are words that replaces nouns: I, me, she, we, they, who, that, your, his, her, it, him, you, those, them, mine, these, their, ours, etc.

# Types of pronouns

There are several types of pronouns:

Personal pronouns, relative pronouns, demonstrative pronouns, reflexive pronouns, interrogative pronouns, and possessive pronouns.

- 1. Personal pronouns refers to a person, place, thing or idea I, me, she, we us, them, it, you, they.
- 2. Demonstrative pronoun refers to nouns that have already been mentioned this, that, these, those, such, none, neither
- 3. Possessive pronoun denotes possessive or ownership of a noun my, our, your, his, her, its, their.
- 4. Reflexive pronoun myself, yourself, ourself, himself, herself, itself, themselves.
- 5. Interrogative pronoun who, whose, what, which.
