2. IV PLACES FOR PLANTS

Plants are grown in different places. These places are given different names on the basis of the types of plants grown there or the purpose the place is used for.

USING THE CLUES GIVEN, NAME THE PLACES WHERE THESE PLANTS ARE GROWN.

1. An area of open land used for growing crops.= FIELD
2. An area of land where trees bearing fruits are grown.= ORCHARD
3. A large farm on which cotton, tea, coffee, tobacco or sugarcane is grown.=
ESTATE
4. A place where plants are grown for sale or for planting elsewhere.=NURSERY
5. A land covered with grass suitable for animals such as cows and sheep to
eat.=PASTURE
6. A building with a roof and sides made of glass used for growing plants that need
warmth. GREENHOUSE
7. 7. A warm place, in which trees bearing oranges are cultivated .= ORANGERY
8. An area of land used for growing crops and rearing animals.=FARM
