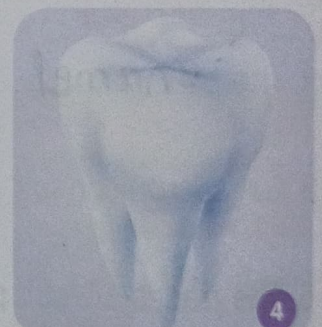
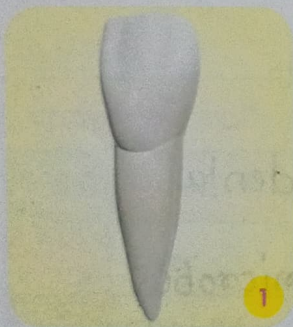


Babies get milk teeth from the age of 6-8 months till the age of 2 years. They are 20 in numbers, are called temporary teeth.
