


10. Adjectives Degrees of Comparison

three degree of comparison.




- * A few adjectives change completely. it's called as irregular adjectives.







4. The compound sentence

* Definition -


A compound sentence is composed of two independent or main clause. (simple sentence)

* Converting simple sentences into compound sentence.


* simple sentence
