Few basic rules:

- 1. Most singular nouns need "S" at the end to become plural.
- 2. Singular nouns ending with s, ss,sh,ch, x or z need "es" at the end of the word to become plural.
- 3. Nouns ending in "y", if there is a consonant before "y" then "y" changes to "i" and then add "es" (ies) at the end of the word to make them plural.
- 4. If the noun ends with "y", if there is a vowel (a,e,i,o,u) before "y", then just add "s" at the end to make the noun plural.
