

Notes

A verb is an action word.

Tense tells us the time of the action. Tenses shows us time in three ways.

- Present
- > Past
- > Future



Simple Present Tense:

- ➤ Used to talk about habits. Eg. He writes very neatly.
- Used to talk about routine/ daily actions. Eg. I brush my teeth every day.
- Used to describes a person in the present time.
 Eg. She is very beautiful.
- Used to talk about a profession of a person.
 Eg. My father is a teacher.

Examples:

- 1.He goes to school.
- 2. We cook every day.
- 3. You have a big house.
- 4. They sleep in the afternoon.
- 5. The earth is spherical.

Simple Past Tense:

- Used to talk about completed actions of the past. Eg. We bought a television yesterday.
- Used to talk about habits of the past. Eg. Karan talked politely with everyone earlier.
- Used to describe a person in the past time. Eg. When she was young, she was very beautiful.
- Used to talk about a profession of a person in the past. Eg. His uncle was a doctor.

Example:

- 1. I saw a movie yesterday.
- 2. Last year, I travelled to Japan.
- 3. Did you have dinner last night?
- 4. She washed her car.
- 5. We were good friends.

Simple Future Tense:

➤ Used to talk about action which will take place in future. Eg. I will go to play after I finish my homework.

Note: She will go for a walk every day.

She goes for a walk every day.

Examples:

- 1. They will play football in that field.
- 2. Bob will go to the library tomorrow.
- 3. We will go shopping in that market this Monday.
- 4. He will close the shop.
- 5. I will make a cup of tea.
