Theme: Animals And Their Habitat

LANGUAGE AND LITERACY: We learnt '/C/c/', '/K/k/', '/E/e/', '/H/h/' sounds and words with these sounds. We traced sand paper, traced in the sand tray, colour the sounds, letter formation with clay to get to know the phonic sound. We worked with '**Mystery Bag**'. We recited jolly phonic rhymes. We heard many stories like: **The Dove and The Ant, Ganesh, Animals Stories, Hanuman.**



NUMERACY: We recognise the objects which are '**Orange and Green**' in colour We can recognise the objects which are '**Square**' in shape. We can count and quantify the numbers - '2, 3 and 4'.
