"Learning in Early Childhood"



The great Physician and Educator **Maria Montessori** said, " **The hands are the instruments of intelligence. The child needs to manipulate objects and to gain experience by touching and handling.**"

Learning in early childhood (birth to age 6) occurs through various experiences and processes. Children learn through play, exploring their environment with materials, observe, imitate adults and peers for learning new things and different behaviours.

In this age child learn the language by interacting with family, caregivers and peers. Developing language skills through reading, talking and listening enables children to express thoughts and ideas. Child learn by actively engaging with their environment, asking questions and seeking answers.

Child gets sensorial experiences by exploring the world through senses (sight, sound, touch, taste and smell), it helps the child to develop the interest and knowledge. Repetition of activities and practicing new skills reinforces learning and builds confidence.

Forming emotional bonds with caregivers and peers lay the foundation for trust, security and self esteem. Caregivers and teachers provide guidance, support and scaffolding to facilitate learning.

As a adult we (parents as well as teacher) need to remember every child is unique and learns at their own pace and early childhood education should prioritize play - based, child centred approaches to foster a lifelong love for learning!!!

A Glance at Learning for the Month : July

LANGUAGE AND LITERACY: We learnt '/I/i/, /P/p/, /N/n/, /C/c/' sounds and words with these sounds. We also learnt many sight words. **Activities :** We heard story related to the sound, recited Jolly Phonic rhymes and traced in sand tray, sand paper. We also enjoyed rainbow tracing, nature walk, journal writing, mystery box activity, dough activity etc...



NUMERACY: We explored with Pre-Number Skills - "more - less, heavy - light". We can count, quantify the numbers from 4 to 7. **Activities :** Activities with number rods, arranging beads, treasure hunt activity and solving worksheet.



GENERAL AWARENESS: We learnt the concepts like 'My Family, Family Members and their occupation, life cycle of human being, friends, my body, keeping clean, emotions, good habits, sense organs'. Activities : solving worksheet, discussion in the circle time, watching video and enacting in role play etc...

MUSIC AND MOVEMENT: We enjoyed reciting rhymes like : In my Room there is Bed, Walking Walking ... etc...

STORIES WE HEARD: Lost Toy, The Magic Porridge Pot, How Leopard Got Spots?, Two Wise Goats.

CREATIVE EXPRESSION: We enjoyed with palm printing, bubble wrap painting and thumb printing.



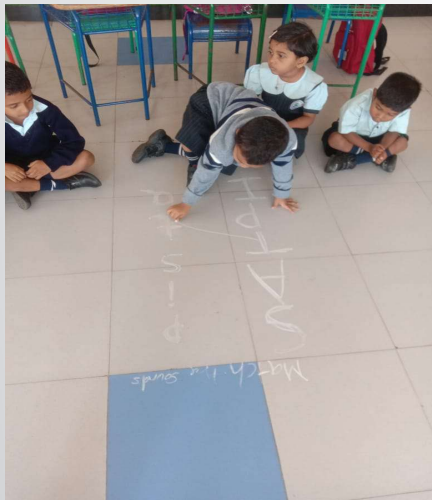
Motor Skill Activities : Rolling and unrolling mat, walking on zig - zag line... Etc...
