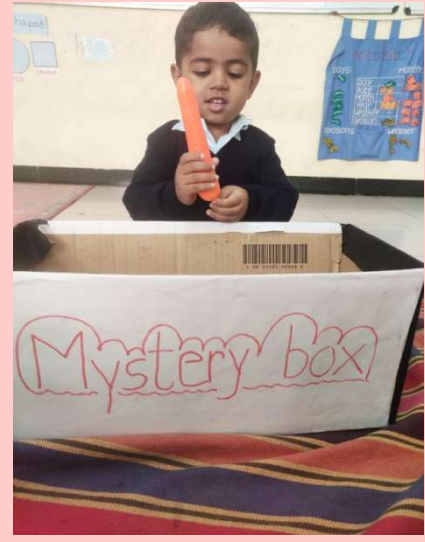

A Glance at Learning for the Month : August

LANGUAGE AND LITERACY: We learnt /C/c/, /K/k/, /E/e/, /H/h/ sounds and words related to these sounds. **Activities :** We heard story related to the sound, recited Jolly Phonic rhymes. We enjoyed the activities like mystery box, play dough, colouring the letter, solving worksheet, colouring the picture with sound, arranging grains on the sound etc..



NUMERACY: We explored with Pre-Number Skills - "rough - smooth, hard - smooth, tall - short, long - short, heavy - light and more - less". We can count and associate the number of objects with its numerals 3 to 5. We can identify the objects which are in 'rectangle', 'orange and purple'. **Activities :** Activities with Geometrical Cabinet, number rods, colour tablets, touch board and solving worksheet.



GENERAL AWARENESS: We learnt the concepts like 'Fruits, Vegetable, Community Helpers, Seasons'.
Activities : Solving worksheet, Discussion in the Circle Time, Sorting fruits - vegetables and Puppet Show etc...



CREATIVE EXPRESSION: We enjoyed with 'Thumb Printing, preparing cat and ball with paper, colouring the sun etc...

STORIES WE HEARD: The Hungry Caterpillar, The Little Laali, The Red Rain Coat, The Mango Tree.



MUSIC AND MOVEMENT: We enjoyed reciting rhymes like : Bits of Paper, Baa Baa Black Sheep, One, Two, Three, Four, Five ..., Mama Loves To Sing...etc...

Motor Skill Activities: Hopping, running, Jumping on number, Standing on one foot, Squeezing sponge Etc...
