A Glance at Learning for the Month February and March

LANGUAGE AND LITERACY: We revised '/A/a/ to /Z/z/' sounds and /i/, /o/ and /u/ family words. Activities: Loud Reading of family words and Solving worksheet



NUMERACY: We can count, quantify the numbers from **41 to 50**, and learnt number names 'eleven to twenty'.
