A Glance at Learning for the Month February and March

LANGUAGE AND LITERACY: We learnt /v/V/, /y/Y/, /x/X/, /q/Q/ sounds, words related to these sounds. CVC words - den, hen, tin, lip, dip, nib, dot etc... **Activities :** We heard story related to the sound, recited Jolly Phonic rhymes. We enjoyed the activities like mystery box, play dough, colouring the letter, solving worksheet, colouring the picture with sound, arranging grains on the sound, arrange the alphabets to construct the words.



NUMERACY: We learnt the Concept of, 'More and Less, Part and Whole, Full and Empty, Thick and Thin, Above and Below Patterns, Numbers 13-20'. **Activities :** Counting beads, Comparing objects, Jumping on number, Arranging beads according to the number, Solving Worksheet etc...



GENERAL AWARENESS: We learnt the concepts like 'Creepy - Crawlies, Life Cycle of Butterfly, Frog and Hen, Air, Land and Water Transport, Road Safety'.
Activities : Colouring Insects, Circle Time Activity, Solving Worksheet.



CREATIVE EXPRESSION: We enjoyed with 'Creating Aeroplane, Bag Puppet, Collage, Eye Mask, Madhubani Art, Kite, Warli Art etc...

STORIES WE HEARD: Brown Bear, Peppa Pig, Good Habit, The Crow and The Peacock, Maisy Learns to Swim, Maisy's Pool, The Hungry Caterpillar, Never Tell Lie etc...



MUSIC AND MOVEMENT: We enjoyed reciting rhymes like : Peacock, Hathi Bhai, One Two, Two Little hands go, Teddy Bear etc...

Motor Skill Activities: Jumping on trampoline, Catching the ball, Walking backwards, Rolling Sideways, Bouncing Ball, Peg Puzzles, Using Tongs to pick up the things etc....
