TENSES	SIMPLE	CONTINUOUS	PERFECT	PERFECT CONTINUOUS
Present	S+V in present tense. I <u>write</u> a letter. He/she <u>writes</u> a letter. They/We/You <u>write</u> a letter.	S+has/am/is/are + V-ing. I <u>am writing</u> a letter. He/she <u>is writing</u> a letter. They/We/You <u>are writing</u> a letter.	S+has/have + PP I <u>have written</u> a letter. He/she <u>has written</u> a letter. They/We/You <u>have written</u> a letter.	S+has/have + been + V-ing. I <u>have been writing</u> a letter. He/she <u>has been writing</u> a letter. They/We/You <u>have been writing</u> a letter.
Past	S+V in past tense. I <u>wrote</u> a letter. He/she <u>wrote</u> a letter. They/We/You <u>wrote</u> a letter.	S+was/were + V-ing. I <u>was writing</u> a letter. He/she <u>was writing</u> a letter. They/We/You <u>were writing</u> a letter.	S+had + PP I <u>had written</u> a letter. He/she <u>had written</u> a letter. They/We/You <u>had written</u> a letter.	S+had + been + V-ing. I <u>had been writing</u> a letter. He/she <u>had been writing</u> a letter. They/We/You <u>had been writing</u> a letter.
Future	S+will/shall + root of V. I <u>will write</u> a letter. He/she <u>will write</u> a letter. They/We/You <u>will write</u> a letter.	S+will/shall + be + V-ing. I <u>will be writing</u> a letter. He/she <u>will be writing</u> a letter. They/We/You <u>will be writing</u> a letter.	S+will/shall + have + PP He/she <u>will have written</u> a letter.	S+will/shall + have + been + V-ing. He <u>will have been writing</u> a letter.
