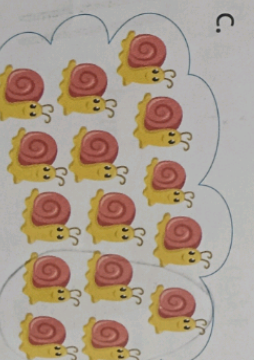

Representing Numbers on the Abacus

An abacus is a tool for counting. The abacus shown here has two rods—ones (O) and tens (T). The rod on the right shows the ones (O) and the rod on the left shows the tens (T).
