- Description List (<dl>) - term and description pairs.

3. Tables are used to display data in rows and columns using tags like <table>, <tr>, <th>, <td>.

4. list-style-image sets an image as bullet. empty-cells controls visibility of empty cells.

5. Table properties:

- border-spacing: sets space between cell borders.
- border-collapse: merges borders.
- caption-side: places caption.
- empty-cells: shows/hides empty cells.
- table-layout: sets layout behavior.

6. A description list shows terms and their meanings, useful for glossaries or FAQs.
