 - e.g., tinyint, Small, Numeric, etc.
- Binary Types: Binary data types are used for storing data in binary formats. Binary data types in a database can be used for storing photos, music files, etc. e.g. Binary, VarBinary, LongVarBinary, etc.
- Date Time: Date time data types are used for describing date and time values for the field used in the table of a database. These data types can be used for storing information such as date of birth, date of admission, date of product sale, etc.
 - e.g. Date, Time, TimeStamp, etc.
- **Alphanumeric Type:** Alphanumeric data type refers to data made up of letters and numbers. Usually, symbols and spaces are also allowed. e.g. Long varchar, char, varchar etc.
