Q7 Different Difference between reusing and recycling non-biodegradable waste.

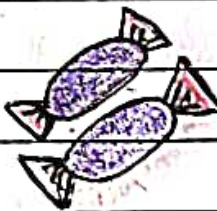
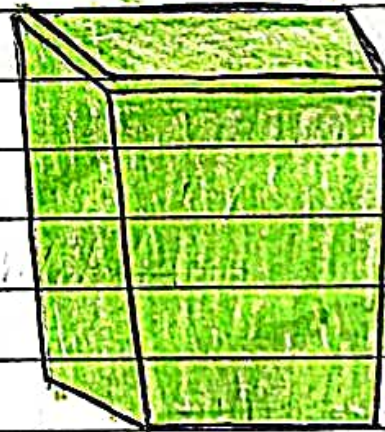
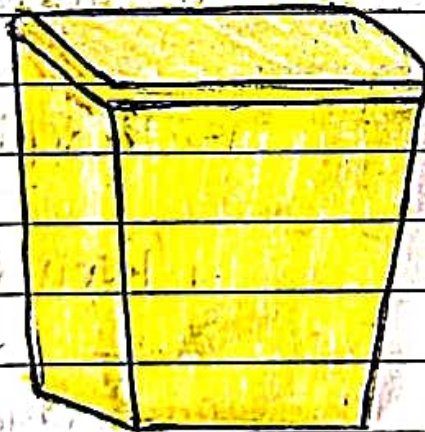
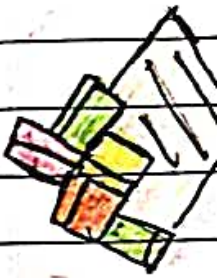
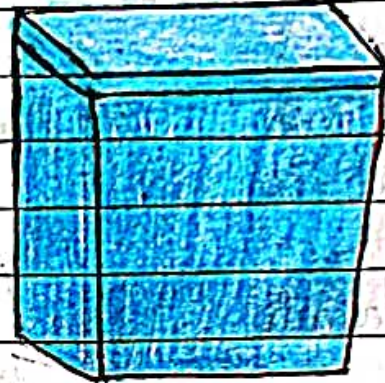
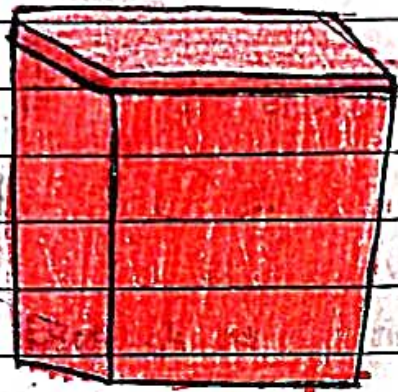
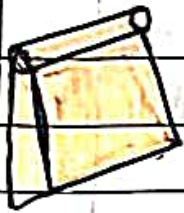
Ans: Reusing means using an old product as it is without changing its form.

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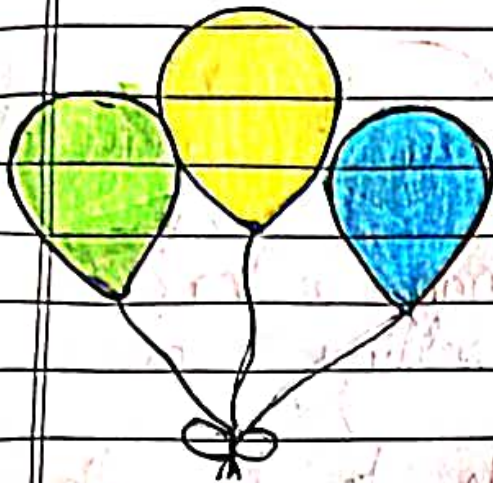

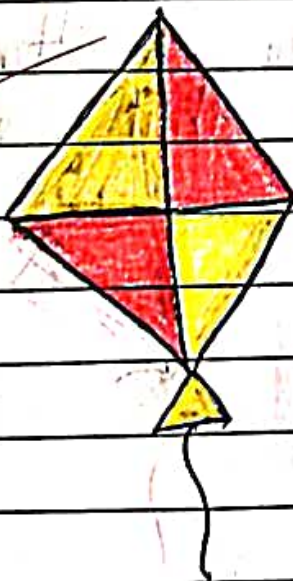

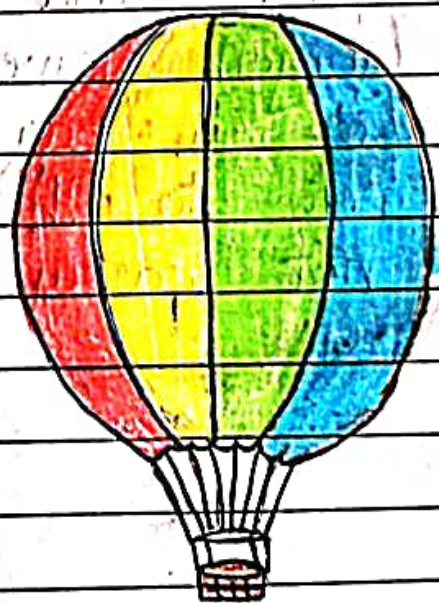
