- a. Web Server b. Web Page c. Web Site d. Web Browser
- **a. Web Server:** A web server is a computer that stores websites and their related files for viewing on the Internet.
- b. Web Page: A single HTML document is called a Web Page.
- c. Web Site: A collection of Web pages is called Web Site.
- **d. Web Browser:** A Web Browser is software that is used to view Web sites on the internet.
- **Q.** What do you mean by ISP?

Ans. ISP stands for Internet Service Provider. It is an organization that provides us access to the Internet via a wired or wireless connection.

- **Q.** Write four advantages of Networking.
- 1) Data Sharing: Networking allows the sharing of data.
- 2) Files Transfer: One User can send text files, spreadsheets, etc. to other users.
- **3) Hardware Sharing:** Hardware components such as printers, scanners, etc. can also be shared.
- **4) Internet Access Sharing:** You can purchase a single Internet connection and share it among other computers in a network
- Q. What do you mean by Modem?

Modem: A modem is a device that converts digital computer signals into a form (analog signals) that can travel over phone lines. It also re-converts the analog signals back into digital signals. The word modem is derived from its function MOdulator/DEModulator.

Q. What do you mean by Instant Messaging? Write its four key features.

Ans – Instant messaging (IM) is a form of communication over the Internet that offers an instantaneous transmission of text-based messages from sender to receiver.

- b) Audio calling and conferencing.

- d) File transfers (For example documents, spreadsheets, audio files, video files, etc.)
