## **Knowledge Nugget**

- . Words such as 'earlier', 'before' and 'later' help us distinguish between events occurring at different times.
- Today means the present day. Yesterday means the previous day.

  Tomorrow means the next day.
- · The days from Monday to Friday are called weekdays.
- · Saturday and Sunday are called weekend.
- A clock or watch is called analog if it has moving hands and hours marked from 1 to 12 to show the time.
- A clock or watch is called digital if it displays time digitally, that is, using numbers.
- o'clock is used after a number from one to twelve to indicate the hour of the day or night.
- Some activities take a longer time to complete than others.
