

Nouns: Concrete and Abstract




Nicky is playing a game called 'touch the concrete and feel the abstract'.

Anything that you cannot see, touch, smell, taste, or hear is abstract.

Concrete nouns are words that refer to objects that we can experience with our five senses: by seeing, smelling, hearing, tasting, and touching.

Abstract nouns are opposite of concrete nouns; they can only be thought of (idea), heard (noise), felt (happiness). They cannot be seen or touched.

An abstract noun refers to qualities (kindness), actions (laughter), and state of being (beauty). In short, they are words that name ideas, feelings, experiences, qualities, and concepts.
