
## Nouns: Common and Proper

A **common noun** is a general name for a class of people, animals, places, and things. A **proper noun** is a particular name given to a person, animal, place, or thing.

## Say it aloud

- A noun refers to anything that is living or non-living, and concrete or abstract.
- A common noun is the general word used to name a class of people, things, animals, and place E.g. man, camel, river, flower, beach, steel, etc.
- A proper noun names a specific person, animal, place, or thing. Every word in a proper noun always starts with a capital letter. E.g. Sania Mirza, Uncle Sam, Doctor Raina, Marina Beach, etc.
