



- A compound noun is made up of two or more nouns combined to form a single noun, e.g. book + mark = bookmark.
- Some compound nouns are written as separate words, e.g. washing machine, United Nation Some are linked by a hyphen, e.g. bird-of-prey, station-master. Some appear as one wor e.g. hamburger, Disneyland.
- A compound noun can be proper or common. The first letter of each word in a proper compound noun is capitalized, e.g. Rajiv Gandhi Park.
