SUBTRACTING 2-DIGIT NUMBERS WITH REGROUPING

Let us recall subtraction with regrouping.

In a parking area, there are 73 bicycles and 49 cars. By how many are the bicycles more than the cars?

Subtract 49 from 73.



Step 1:

Compare the numbers under ones.

$$3 < 9.$$

9 cannot be subtracted from 3.

Step 2:

Regroup 73.

$$73 = 7 \text{ tens} + 3 \text{ ones}$$

$$= 6 \text{ tens} + 1 \text{ ten} + 3 \text{ ones}$$

$$= 6 \text{ tens} + 10 \text{ ones} + 3 \text{ ones}$$

$$= 6 \text{ tens} + 13 \text{ ones}$$
