

	3	10	$3 \times 10 = 30$
	5	6	$5 \times 6 = 30$
	4	8	$4 \times 8 = 32$

Use multiplication tables and fill in the blanks.

| $6 \times 7 = 42$ | $2 \times 9 = 18$  |
| $3 \times 6 = 18$ | $4 \times 8 = 32$  |
| $9 \times 8 = 72$ | $7 \times 10 = 70$ |
| $6 \times 6 = 36$ | $6 \times 9 = 54$  |
| $8 \times 7 = 56$ | $4 \times 10 = 40$ |
