Birth date and place

Awards or recognitions

Major contributions to society

5. Challenges and Struggles

Difficulties they faced

How they overcame them

6. Later Life and Death (if applicable)

Their later years

Date and place of death

7. Legacy/Impact

How are they remembered today?

What can we learn from their life?

8. Conclusion

Your personal opinion or message about the person

Add a photo or drawing of the person.

Use bullet points or subheadings.

Decorate with quotes, timeline, or a fact box.

Use color coding for different sections.

Include a “Did You Know?” corner with fun facts.
