

1. The competition will be held simultaneously at the following three centers on December 5, 2024, as per the groups below.

The subject of the artwork will be announced at the competition venue on the day of the event.

Rules of the Competition:

- 2. No entry fee will be charged for the competition.
- 3. The competition will be held on a single day at all centres simultaneously on Thursday, December 5,
- 4. Only students with a strong interest in art should be selected to participate in the competition.
- 5. All participants will receive certificates. Schools are requested to submit participant lists for each group to our representatives at the competition centre.
- 6. Drawing paper will be provided by the College of Art; participants should bring their own art supplies to the competition venue.
- 7. Topics for the artwork will be announced on the day of the competition.
- 8. The competition will be held within the specified time for each group.
- 9. Schools should arrange transportation for students to and from the competition venue.
- 10. After the competition, all artwork will be evaluated by experienced and qualified judges. Their decision will be final, and results will be communicated to all schools. Schools are requested to provide an email address along with the school's address to our representative.
- 11. The medium to be used for painting is specified in this letter.
- 12. The organizers reserve the right to publish the artwork. Entries will not be returned to participants.
- 13. Details of competition centres, dates, and timings are provided in the attached poster.
- 14. Awards will be distribute as first, second, third, and three consolation certificates presented to each group (Grades 1-2, 3-4, 5-7, and 8-10). Prizes will include trophies, certificates, and art materials.
- 15. Please note that the Prize distribution ceremony will be held on February 2025 on the Annual Art Exhibition of Vasai Vikasini's Collage of Visual Arts, Vasai (East).
