Dear Parents of Classes 1 to 9,

As we come to the end of the academic year 2024 – 2025 and prepare for the new academic year 2025 – 2026, I wish to bring the following to your attention:

- 1. Answer scripts of Classes 4 to 9 (2024-2025) will be shown to students only, on Tuesday, March 18, 2025 from 10.00 a.m. to 12.45 p.m.
- 2. On Saturday, March 29, 2025, students will come to school at 09.00 a.m. to collect their reports. The reports will be distributed to students only. Parents/authorized persons, who are unable to send their children to school on this day, may collect their reports between 11.00 a.m. and 11.30 a.m. only. Students are to hand in their School ID Cards to their Class Teacher when they come to collect their reports.
- 3. Students must report on time and in <u>full school uniform</u> (proper shoes, haircut, etc.) on both these days, failing which, they will NOT be shown their answer scripts or given their reports. **The reports of students whose fees have not been paid will be withheld**.
- 4. School re-opens for Classes 1 to 10 on Tuesday, April 01, 2024. Students of Classes 1 to 10 will report to school at 08.00 a.m. and will go home by 01.00 p.m. Attendance is compulsory. Students will receive their school diaries, ID cards and other important instructions, from their respective class teachers, on this day.
- 5. Parents are informed that the school will have an interaction with parents on **Saturday, April 05, 2025**.

Classes 1 and 2 - Time: 08.00 am to 08.45 am.

Classes 3 and 4 - Time: 09.00 am to 09.45 am.

Classes 5 and 6 - Time: 10.00 am to 10.45 am.

Classes 7 and 8 - Time: 11.00 am to 11.45 am.

Classes 9 and 10 - Time: 12.00 noon to 12.45 pm.

6. School Discipline

a. <u>School Uniform</u>: You are reminded that black shoes with laces (boys)/with a buckle (girls), white socks, except during the monsoon, and a short simple haircut are a part of the school uniform. Fancy haircuts (fashions), high-heeled shoes (even on birthdays), ornaments, wrist bands, etc. and the application of mehndi are not permitted. Students will not be admitted to class.

- b. Students are not permitted to leave the school premises during the breaks.
- c. <u>Respect for School Property</u>: Defacing school walls and furniture will attract a penalty or a fine. Chewing gum is <u>banned</u> on the school premises.
- d. <u>Leave</u>: All absenteeism must be recorded <u>briefly and accurately</u> in the LEAVE RECORD pages, in the school diary. Leave during the course of the year is discouraged.
 - Except for an illness, if any leave is to be taken for a function, an outing or for serious, personal reasons, it must always be applied for, well in advance. This procedure must be followed even if a student is to be absent for a day or a holiday is to be added to a weekend.
- e. <u>Cleanliness and Care of the Environment and School Diary</u>: We urge you to motivate your child to keep the school environment clean and avoid wastage and misuse of water. The school diary must be kept neat and tidy.
- f. <u>Traffic regulations</u> imposed in the school premises and at the entrance are in the interest of all, especially the students, and must be observed by all vehicle owners. The school premises should <u>NOT</u> be used as a thoroughfare. Parking, especially two-wheelers, is <u>not permitted</u> in front of the school gates. This is dangerous and hampers the smooth flow of traffic.

7. Other Matters

- a. <u>Communication</u> regarding the student's progress, leave and absence etc. will be discussed with the parents only, unless there is a written communication to the school, authorizing a guardian to deal with such matters.
- b. <u>School business</u>, viz. applications for leave, bonafide certificates etc. will not be transacted during the vacations.
- c. <u>Visiting Hours</u>, for the <u>Principal</u>, by <u>prior appointment</u>, only. The School Office will be open to Parents / Visitors from 09.00 a.m. to 10.30 a.m. only.
- d. <u>Security</u>: Kindly adhere to the schedule of the Visiting Hours. Unless called to school, parents are not permitted to stay on the premises during the breaks or at any other time. Appointments with teachers must be recorded in the school diary.
- e. You are requested to communicate with your child and other students, in English only, while you are on the school premises. This is in the interest of your child and the school.
- 8. <u>School Fees</u>: It is <u>mandatory</u> that the fees are paid by the <u>stipulated date</u>. Submit the 'school copy' of the receipt promptly, to the school office and preserve your copy till the end of the academic year.
